Privacy Policy

Effective March 11, 2024

- Information Collection: FOLP collects personal information you provide when you volunteer or make a donation. This information includes your name, email address, phone number, or any other data gathered through the website or provided to us through other means, such as mailing us a donation. FOLP does not have access to your credit card information, which you may have used to donate. A third party encrypts, processes, and maintains credit card information.
- **Purpose of Data Collection:** FOLP collects information from you to document your interaction with us, including your donation and volunteer history. The information allows us to carry out the FOLP mission and activities.
- **Data Usage:** FOLP uses the information we collect to communicate with you and to provide programs and events.
- **Data Sharing:** FOLP only shares data regarding you with FOLP Board Members and volunteers solely for the organization's purposes and objectives. We do not sell any information.
- Data Protection and Security: The FOLP website is hosted securely by a website service provider. The website uses traffic encryption, known as hypertext transfer protocol secure (HTTPS), which secures the transmission of information to and from a website. The only information we have regarding you is the information you provide.
- User Rights: You may see the information FOLP has regarding you in your online account, or you may contact FOLP for the information. You have the right to request that we change or delete your information. You may also unsubscribe from receiving information from us. If you appear in a photograph or video taken at an FOLP event and we use it on the website or social media, you can ask us to remove or discontinue the use of the image.
- **Cookies and Tracking:** FOLP does not use persistent cookies or any other persistent tracking technology. Our website provider, WildApricot, uses cookies to assist with website navigation. FOLP does not use Google Analytics or any similar technology to track or evaluate your use of our website.
- **Policy Updates:** This policy may change over time. The then-current copy will be available on the website.
